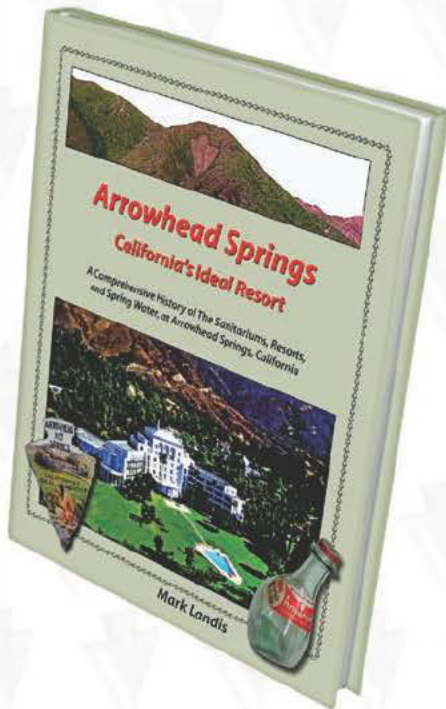

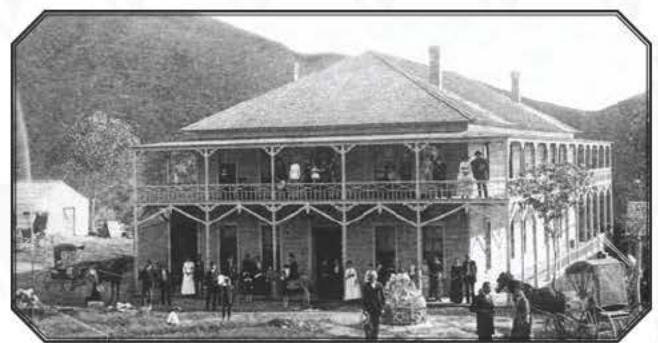

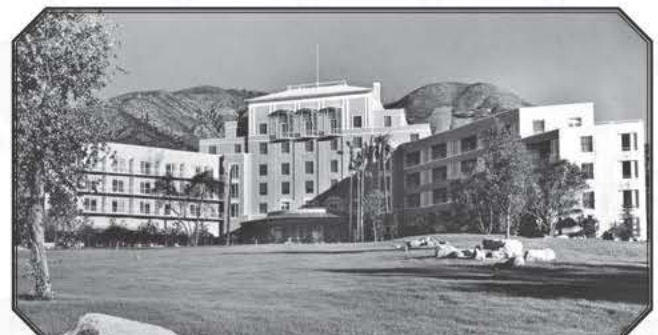
The Infirmary, circa 1864
